WW2 Crime & Life on Homefront - Risk Assessment

This Site Risk Assessment is designed to apply to all Interior & Exterior sites that the Happening History Team visits.

SITE HAZARDS	Display items set out on floor or tables
PHYSICAL HAZARDS	Slips and trips Splinters from wooden items Possible chaffing and nipping from handcuffs Cuts, bruises resulting from falling or tripping over display items such as Morrison shelter Injury resulting from misuse of display items
HEALTH RISKS	Cuts and Bruises. Nits & Head lice
PERSONS AT RISK	Happening History Staff Students & teaching staff
PRINCIPAL PRECAUTIONS	Ensure access to and from displays are clear Ensure fire exits are kept clear of display items Ensure students and teachers are aware of potential hazards Teacher in charge to ensure that a first aid point is identified to the Happening History staff Ensure wooden items are sanded and splinter free Safe work systems Safety briefs on possible display hazards and the misuse of display items to students and teachers Inform students not to leave display items on floor Spray inside of helmets with anti head lice repellent spray between schools
