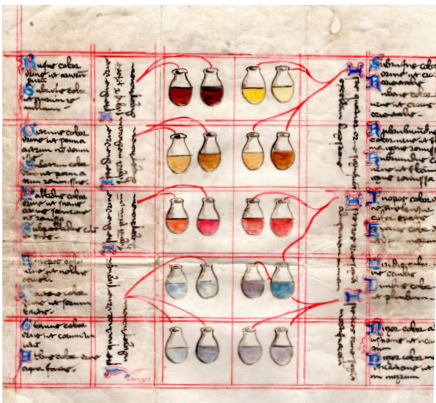


Medieval Physician
