| PRINCIPAL PRECAUTIONS | Ensure access to and from displays are clear |
| | Event organiser to ensure that a first aid point is identified to the Happening History staff |
| | Ensure display area is never left unattended |
| | Inform members of the public of any potential hazards |
| | Safe work systems |
| | Ensure all metal display items are free from burrs and sharp edges |
| | Double rope off backs and sides of display so that it is clear that access is only from the front |
