Arms & Armour Display - Risk Assessment

This Site Risk Assessment is designed to apply to all interior & exterior sites that the Happening History Team visits.

SITE HAZARDS	Display items set out on floor or tables
PHYSICAL HAZARDS	Slips and trips Cuts, bruises resulting from falling or tripping Nipped fingers from trying on Armour or Fastening Belts Injury resulting from misuse of display items
HEALTH RISKS	Cuts and Bruises
PERSONS AT RISK	Happening History Staff Members of the public
PRINCIPAL PRECAUTIONS	Ensure access to and from displays are clear Event organiser to ensure that a first aid point is identified to the Happening History staff Ensure display area is never left unattended Inform members of the public of any potential hazards Safe work systems Ensure all metal display items are free from burrs and sharp edges Double rope off backs and sides of display so that it is clear that access is only from the front
