SITE HAZARDS	Display items set out on floor or tables
PHYSICAL HAZARDS	Slips and trips Cuts, bruises resulting from falling or tripping over display items Splinters from wooden items such as stocks Nipped or bruised skin from public misuse of stock, pillories or equipment Burns from touching fire
HEALTH RISKS	Cuts and Bruises Burns
PERSONS AT RISK	Happening History Staff Members of the public
PRINCIPAL PRECAUTIONS	Ensure access to and from displays are clear Ensure display area is never left unattended Inform public of any potential hazards Event organiser to ensure that a first aid point is identified to the Happening History staff Ensure all wooden items such as stocks and pillories are all smoothly sanded Ensure a fire if used as part of the display is double roped and out of reach of the public Ensure a fire extinguisher and bucket of water are kept on hand at all times.
