Medieval Milling - Risk Assessment

This Site Risk Assessment is designed to apply to all Interior sites that the Happening History Team visits.

SITE HAZARDS	Display items set out on floor/tables Quern stone
PHYSICAL HAZARDS	Nips or bumps from use of quern stone Tripping over display items Choking on bread or grains Chaff or grain in eye from using winnowing basket
HEALTH RISKS	Wheat/gluten allergy
PERSONS AT RISK	Members of the public
PRINCIPAL PRECAUTIONS	Ensure quern stone is supervised by member of Happening History staff at all times and that it is used in an appropriate manner Do not allow members of the public to consume grains, flour or bread (reaction to wheat/gluten is very mild compared to nut allergies and involves consuming food) Inform public of any possible risks Event organiser to ensure that a first aid point is identified to the Happening History staff Provide safety goggles for public to use whilst winnowing if they wish Safe work systems
